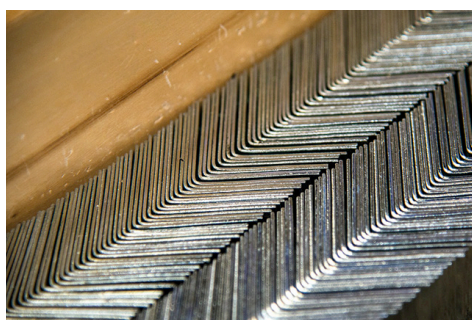


Woodinville's Strasser Makes Powder Rooms Plush

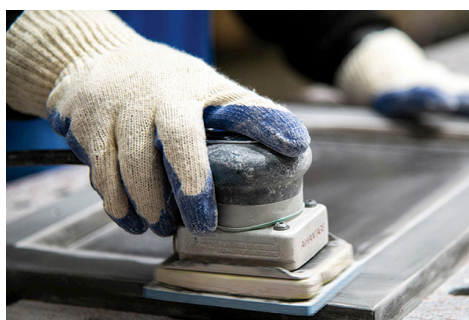
The company, based in a 35,000-square-foot facility in Woodinville, was founded in 1982 by Robert Strasser



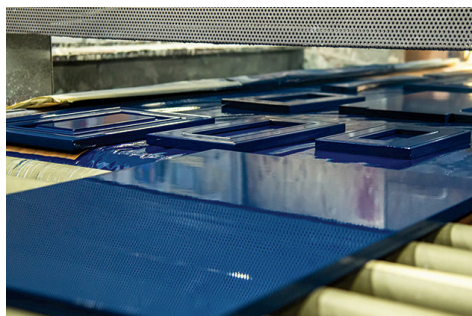
Strasser designs and manufactures hardwood bathroom vanities, cabinets and accessories, offering customers some 15,000 possible product combinations. The company, based in a 35,000-square-foot facility in Woodinville, Washington, just east of Bothell, was founded in 1982 by Robert Strasser. It was acquired by current owner and President Andy Hedreen in the 1980s and now employs about 50 people. "Strasser produces approximately 13,000 to 15,000 vanities per year," says Peter Ollestad, vice president of sales.
